## This week's daily readings:

**Sunday, Acts 1:1-5.** Jesus told the disciples to wait for the promise of the Holy Spirit in Jerusalem. In what part of your life do you find yourself waiting for something? The disciples waited together. Give thanks for the resources God has given you as you wait.

*Monday, Acts 1: 6-11.* What is your Samaria, a place or people you would rather not connect with?

*Tuesday, Acts 1:12-14.* As the disciples waited, they devoted themselves to prayer. Pray that your eyes will be open to see where a word or action of witness is needed today.

*Wednesday, Acts 1: 15-26.* Matthias is chosen to replace Judas. Pray for those recently baptized at the Easter Vigil (two young girls and a baby boy) and the three families who joined the church.

*Thursday, Psalm 150.* The psalmist praises God in the sanctuary and in nature (the firmament). Be conscious of praising God today as you are outside.

*Friday, John 20:19-31.* Picture Jesus coming through the locked door of your life, or someone else's life, to offer peace.

**Saturday, Mark 6:7-13.** This is the story of Jesus sending out the twelve on a missionary journey. To stay at the house until you leave means to really be present. Practice being present today.
