This week's daily readings:

Sunday, 1 Corinthians 15: 1-7. Who passed along the faith to you? Give thanks for them. To whom are you passing along the faith? Pray for them.

Monday, 1 Corinthians 15:8-11. By the grace of God I am what I am... Paul started out persecuting Christians, and God grabbed hold of him. Give thanks that you are who you are by the grace of God. Pray for someone who needs to experience the presence and power of God.

Tuesday, 1 Corinthians 15:12-28. At the end, Christ will destroy every enemy, including death. Pray for those in hospice care, and for those who care for them.

Wednesday, 1 Corinthians 15:35-49. What needs to die in you today so that new life can arise? Remember your baptism, and that you have died and been raised with Christ.

Thursday, 1 Corinthians 15: 50-58. Be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the work of the Lord. How is it difficult for you to be steadfast today? Ask the Holy Spirit for help.

Friday, 1 Corinthians 16:1-9. Pray for a wide door opening for ministry. Are there adversaries? Pray for them.

Saturday, 1 Corinthians 16:10-24. Pray that all that you do today be done in love.
