Read the passage. What shines for you in the text? Why do you think that is? What is God calling you to do, change, or become?

This week's daily readings:

Sunday, Luke 1:26-38. When have I been perplexed with life and wondered what God was up to? How might that have turned out to be a blessing?

Monday, Luke 1:39-56. God had also been at work in the life of Elizabeth. For whom can I give God thanks as I see God at work in his or her life?

Tuesday, Matthew 1:1-25. Emmanuel means "God is with us." Picture God at work in a particular way in a situation.

Wednesday, Psalm 89:1-4, 19-26. When have you seen the faithfulness of God to all generations?

Thursday, Luke 2:1-7. Where am I being inconvenienced? How can I see the blessing of God in this situation?

Friday, Luke 2:8-20. The shepherds were looked down upon by everyone in society, but they were the first to receive this good news. Picture the grace and mercy of God going to people with whom you struggle.

Saturday, Psalm 148. Picture specific places in Oregon praising God!
