**Thursday, Revelation 21:1-6**. Pray about the year ahead, and picture God with you in every situation. Friday, Isaiah 43:18-19. God is doing a new thing! What can you picture God doing in this new year? Saturday, Jeremiah 29:11. Take heart in the hopeful plans of God for you!
